A BILL FOR AN ACT

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR 'ŌLELO HAWAI'I INITIATIVE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I PURPOSE

'Ōlelo Hawai'i is one of the two official languages of Hawai'i (Hawai'i State Constitution, Article XV, Section 4) yet the opportunity to learn the language at the flagship, University of Hawai'i at Mānoa Campus is limited to formal, for-credit classes.

The purpose of this Conversational 'Ōlelo Hawai'i Initiative is to provide an opportunity and space for UHM students to learn and speak the Hawaiian language at least once a week through an informal, non-credit interaction with Native or fluent speakers at a centralized location on the Mānoa Campus.

SECTION II APPROPRIATIONS


SECTION III PROVISIONS
